So Paul can answer your enquiry, may I please glean a little more information from vou?

Below is a checklist which, once answered will inform Paul as to what you may need and what that may cost.

These are questions Paul will ask anyway, it just saves a lot of time prior to a call back to discuss this.



RV Power Checklist

This serves as a guide towards happy camping. We understand each trip may be different.

What make, model and year of RV do you have?

What equipment do you want to run?

In addition to the basics like lights & water pump, will you be using an electric fridge, Sleep Apnea Machine, TV, stereo, satellite dish, coffee machine, electric cooking, fans, computer, toaster, kettle, charging mobile phones / camera / tablet / drone etc.

How many and what type of fridges do you run?

Is it a 3-way fridge (gas/12V/240V) or a compressor style fridge (12/24V or 240V only) What make and model is your fridge? Do you use it as a fridge, freezer or both?

How much power does certain equipment use?

If you are wanting to run or charge specific equipment, such as a coffee machine, or induction cooktop, we will ask you to have a look at the specifications for that item to determine how many Watts or Amps that item uses.

We might also ask how often and how long you might use it for each day.

Where & when do you like to go camping?

North? South? Anywhere I can get away?

What type of camping do you do?

Do you drive from caravan park to caravan park with a couple of overnight stays in between?

Are you a "Rover" who likes to stay a few days here, then drive to another camp for a few days? Are you travelling for long or short periods in between.

If you find a great off-the-grid camping spot, what's the maximum time you'd stay?





Do you live full time in your RV and infrequently visit powered caravan parks or avoid them altogether?

Do you have Solar Panels and if so, are they fixed to your RV or portable and how many and what size?

If safe to do so, please provide photos of the roof space to determine the potential to add solar capacity.

Please attach PHOTOS of the existing batteries and associated equipment and surrounding layout of RV.

Nice wide shots of all equipment please so Paul can see the location and what's around it, like seating, beds, cupboards etc. We can always zoom in.

FOR EXAMPLE:



- Do you take a generator? If so what make and model?
- **BUDGET:** We always do our utmost to tailor an installation just right for you.
